## **1.0 General Information**

### **1.1 Application Overview**

The Abavubi Mobile App is a project under the Responsible Fisheries Business Chain Project developed by the Federation of Fisheries Organisations in Uganda – FFOU with Support from the German Cooperation.

The Application is intended to help the Fisher Folk to keep track, collect, store, and easily analyse business and Fisheries data.

The App will also give the Fisher Folk quick and easy access to weather forecasts, market information and navigation data among other functions to build an empowered stronger fisheries community in the co-management of the fish resources.

### **1.2 App: Modules and Organization**

In general, The Abavubi Fishers Mobile App is composed of a:-

- a) User Registration and Management Module
- b) Market Place
- c) Personal Accounting Module
- d) Safety and Navigation
- e) USSD Offline Accessibility
- f) In – App Help Module

## **2.0 System Summary**

Section explains about the hardware and software requirements for accessing Abavubi Fisher application and user access levels.

## 2.1 Hardware and Software Requirements

Requires a smart phone with Android operating system (OS), the minimum Android version should be 4.0.3 and up to avail all the features in the application. To download and use the functionalities of Abavubi mobile app, you require an Internet connection in your mobile.

## 2.2 User Access Levels

There are 5 five types of registered user roles in Abavubi application.

- a) Fisher
- b) The Fish Traders
- c) The Processors
- d) The Gears & Input dealers
- e) The buyers of Fish or the General public

### 2.2.1 Roles

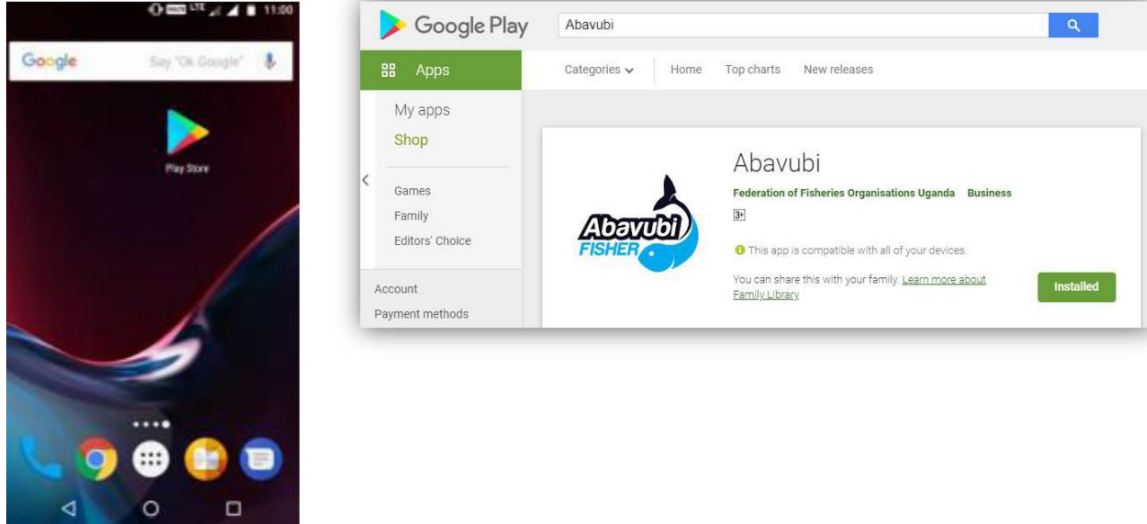
- a) Fisher: Should be registered with an organised body at a landing site or a public department authorised by the Ministry of Fisheries.
- b) Fisher Traders: These buy fish from the fish monger and reseller them to the final consumer.
- c) Processors: Can be an individual, group, company or association who the organization can sell processed fish organization and companies.

## 3.0 How to download the Application

The Abavubi Fisher Mobile App can easily be downloaded using the following ways:  
Google Playstore and The Abavubi Web portal

### 3.1 Google Play Store

Open Play Store application on your mobile by clicking on the Play Store icon as shown in the image below.



Click on the Google Play text at the top and enter the text "abavubi" in the search bar.

Click on the **abavubi** application icon from the search result. Now as shown on your right will open the app abavubi prompting you to install the application. Click on the **"INSTALL"** button to install the application.

### 3.2 Abavubi Fisher Web portal

Abavubi application can be downloaded from web portal as shown below.

#### On click of Google Play Icon

Open any of the browser (google chrome, mozilla firefox etc ) on your computer and enter the URL [www.abavubi.org](http://www.abavubi.org) to open the Abavubi web portal.

On Click of the **Google Play icon**, it will be redirected to Play Store app.

Click on **"INSTALL"** button to install the application.

## 4.0 User Registration and Management

- A User of the Abavubi application in this regard is anyone whose intention to SignUp is to get access to a marketplace and their only interest is to buy fish online. They do not need any rights apart from being able to buy fish, change their login passwords and register.

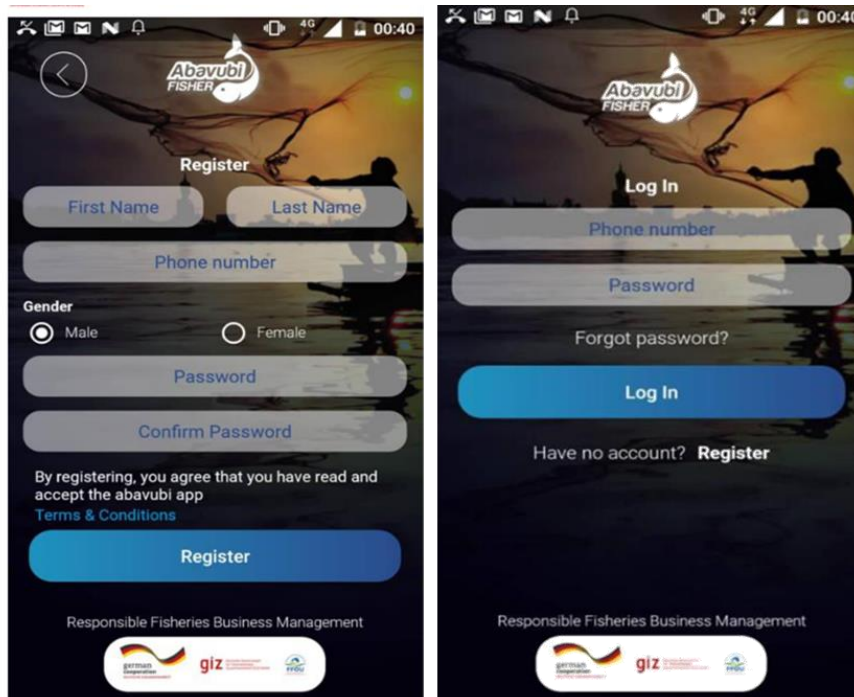
### 4.1 User - PRIVILEGES

Following features can be to the basic user.

- View list of products posted by sellers in the Marketplace
- Express interest / Enquire about an item posted
- Advanced Filters
- Can view the notifications.
- Can order for fish and non fish items
- Market Price
- Have access to this user manual

### 4.2 New user Registration

After a successful process of downloading and installation of the Abavubi App explained above, The App will open as follows and new users can click on register to **signup**.



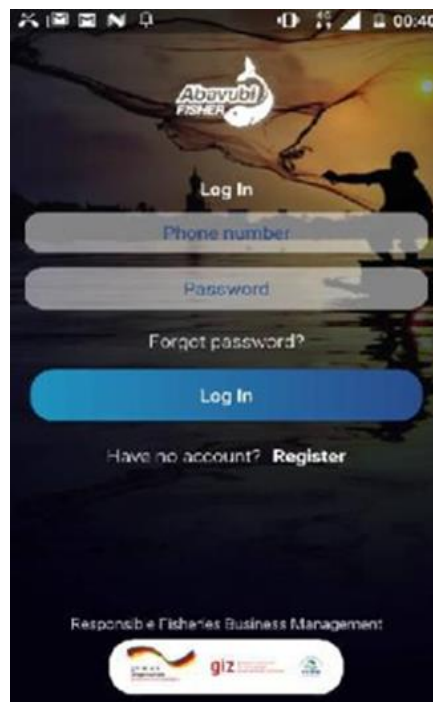
By clicking on the **REGISTER** button on the right, it opens up the Registration **Form** on the Left.

The form requires your basic credentials such as names, gender, telephone number and you setting up your desired password you will be using every time you opt to use the Abavubi App.

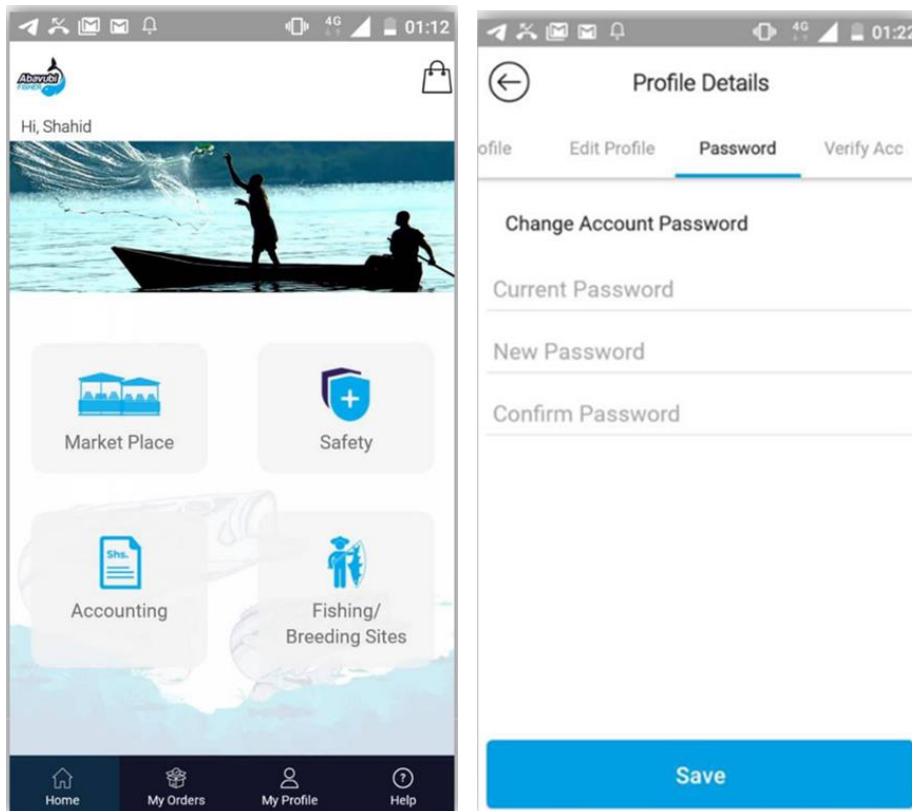
**Note:** At registration, you are warned to read and submit to the Terms and Conditions of Using the Abavubi App.

## 4.4 How to change Profile & Password

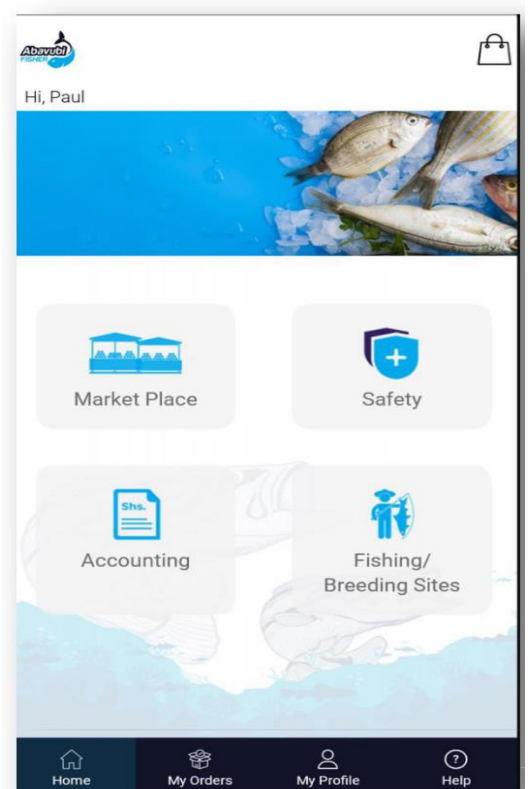


By clicking on My Profile on the footer (see right) this above page will open. Choose the **Password TAB** and you choose to change to a simpler password from time to time as you choose to do.

## 5.0 Main Menu and App Dashboard

As soon as the Abavubi Mobile application is launched, the App dashboard will be displayed which shows the main features of the application as shown in the image.

The dashboard opens with, a shopping cart on far right, and a scrollable rectangular slider that scrolls left and right and is a reserved Ads area.





The menu hosts 4 modules, The Marketplace, Safety module, Accounting Module, and as well as the Fishing and Breeding sites module.

In the footer is the Hand reach quick menu with Home icons, My Orders icon, My profile and the Help which provide a go back to the menu when one is scrolling throughout the App.

## 5.1 Modules of the Abavubi Fishers App.

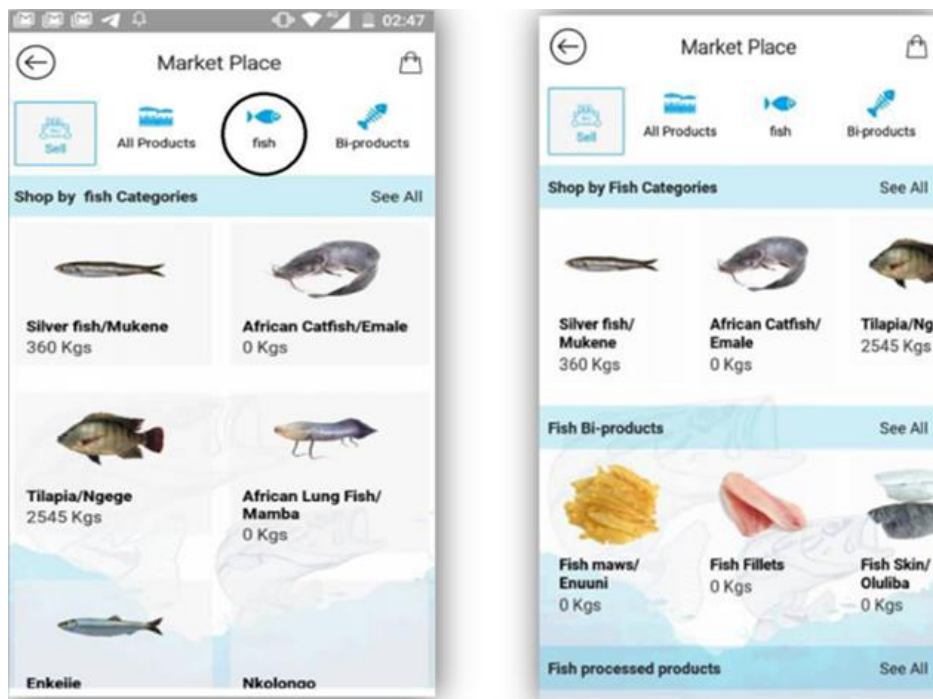
Modules in the App define the centre of the major App functionality, of the whole App.

### 5.1.1 The Marketplace

The Marketplace is a ***'digital market' with transparent product pricing and trends based on posts and sales available to fishers and retailers.*** It shows fish and fish categories market trends every day.

In the marketplace items in each category are displayed and sorted according to quantities posted and most featured types. Marketplace items are displayed according to category.

The image above. Meanwhile, The Marketplace displays items as a summary of posts made by a group of fishers.

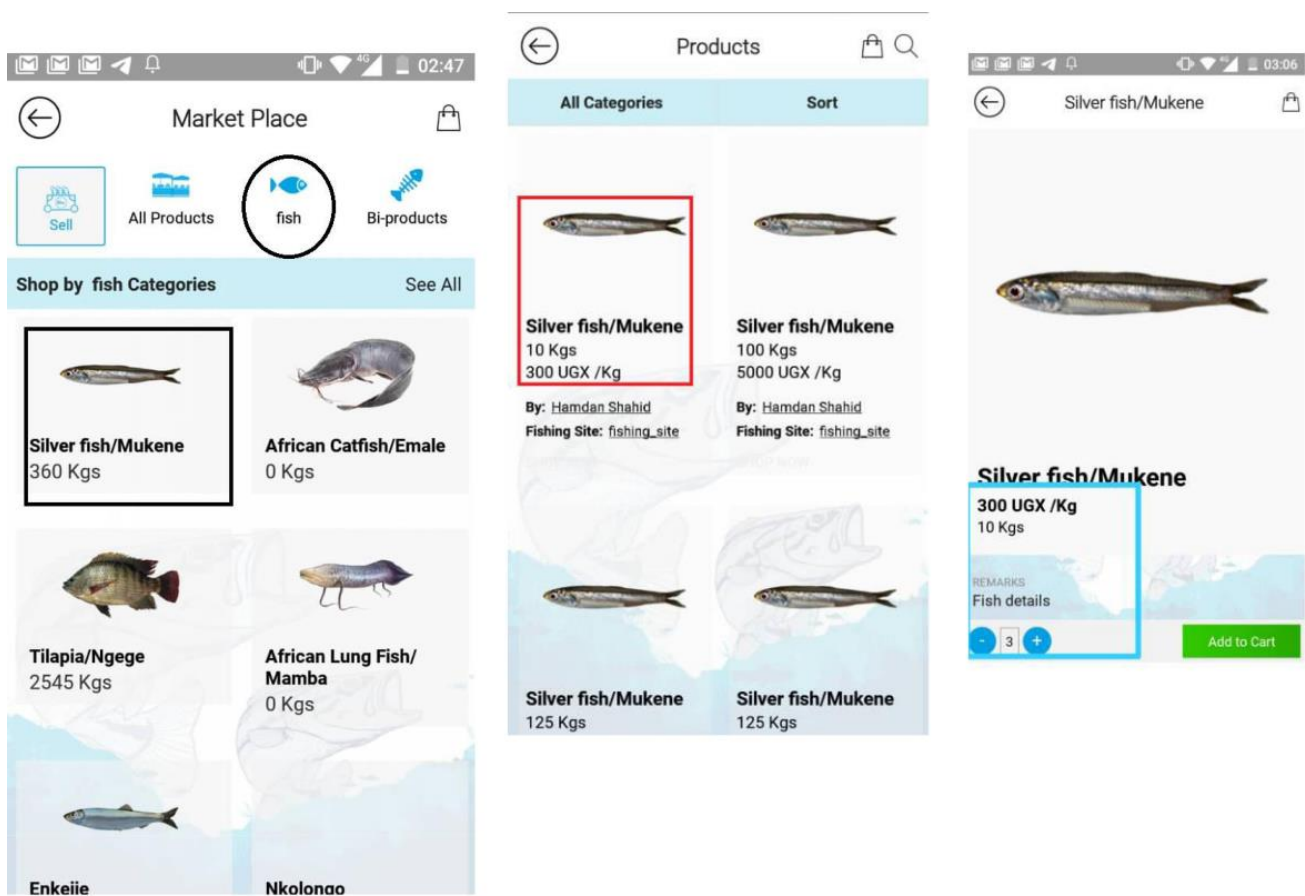
By clicking on a category, **ONLY** i.e. by clicking on Fish category, only fish is displayed as in

### 5.1.2 How to order

a. Click on Fisher Type You need to buy.

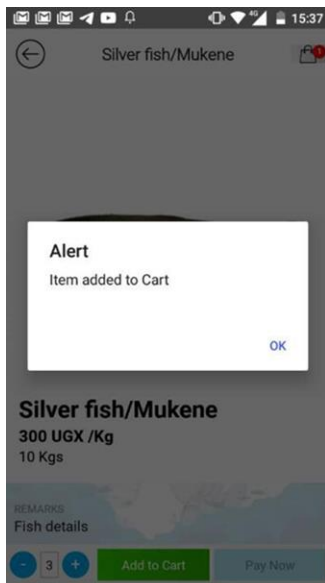
b. You are now free to choose your favourite supplier depending on Price, Location, and quantities

c. Use the addition (+) or subtraction(-) to choose how many quantities you need to buy



Then after choose Add to Cart

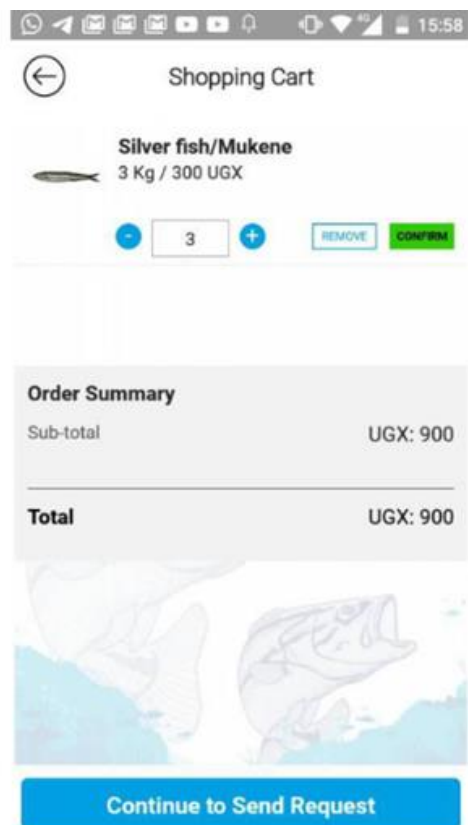
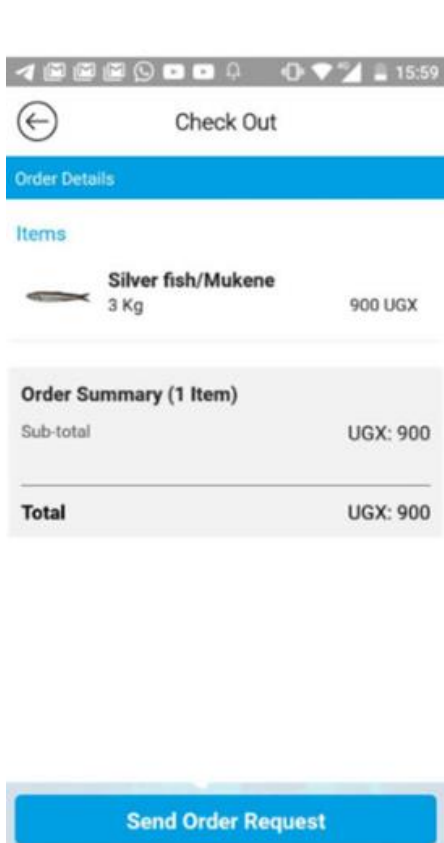
d) Prompts Item added to Cart



e. Pay Now button activates and CART (On top right notifies with adding the unit)



f). To confirm your order and continue to Payments – CLICK Pay Now



Here you are crosschecking your order and you are at freedom to reduce items in your CART or increase them.

### 5.1.3 How Payment requests are handled by the Application:

#### If one is Buying

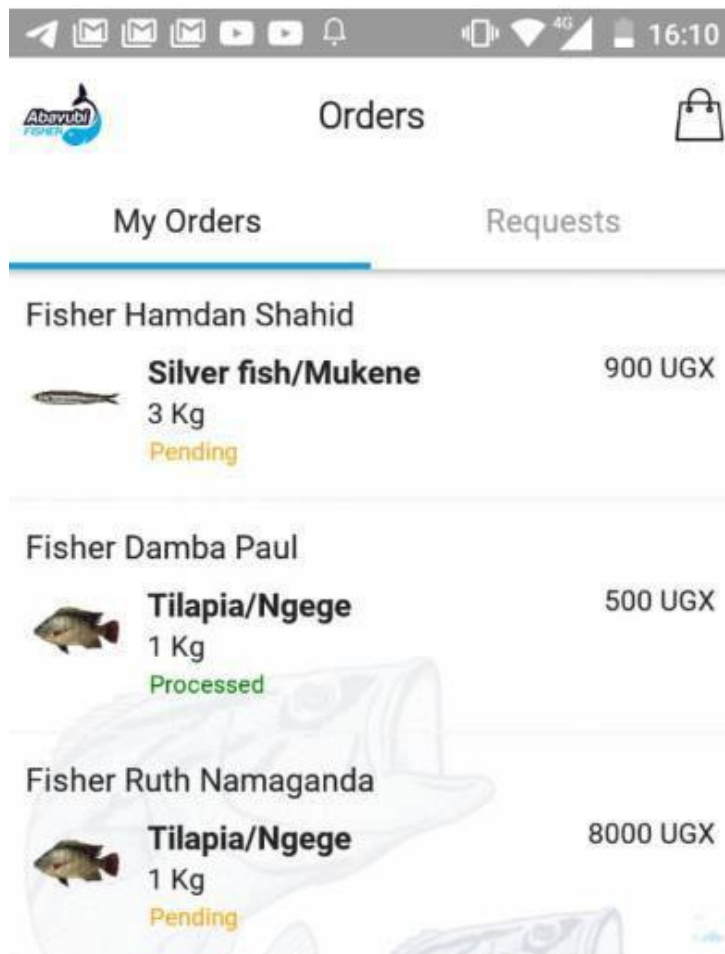
There are 3 three types of status quo one needs to know;

**State 1: Pending** – This is the state in which your order reaches the fish supplier

**State 2: Processing** - When seller has approved your order request, This also activates the **PAYNOW** button for client to pay using Mobile Money.

**State 3: Processed** – When you have paid up your order using the In App mobile money system

#### g). This is the layout of User Orders and Requests

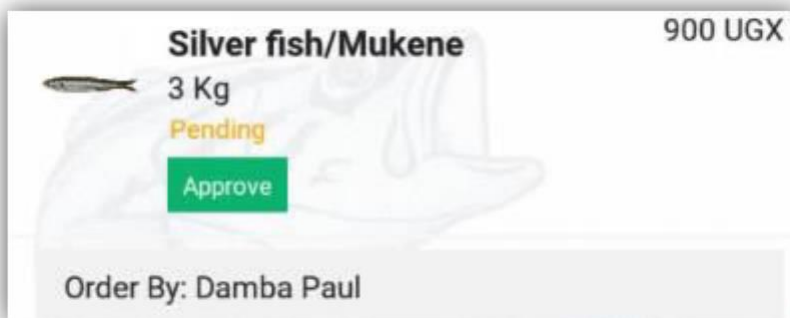


As you can see from the first order on in my orders list, when i sent an order request, the order automatically switched to pending.

Pending means – You are waiting for a confirmation from the seller to **AFFIRM** whether he has what you are ordering for.

**If one is selling**, only One status is apprehended in the Seller side;

**h). In Order Requests, when seller clicks on Approve - the Buyer order status changes from pending to Processing.**

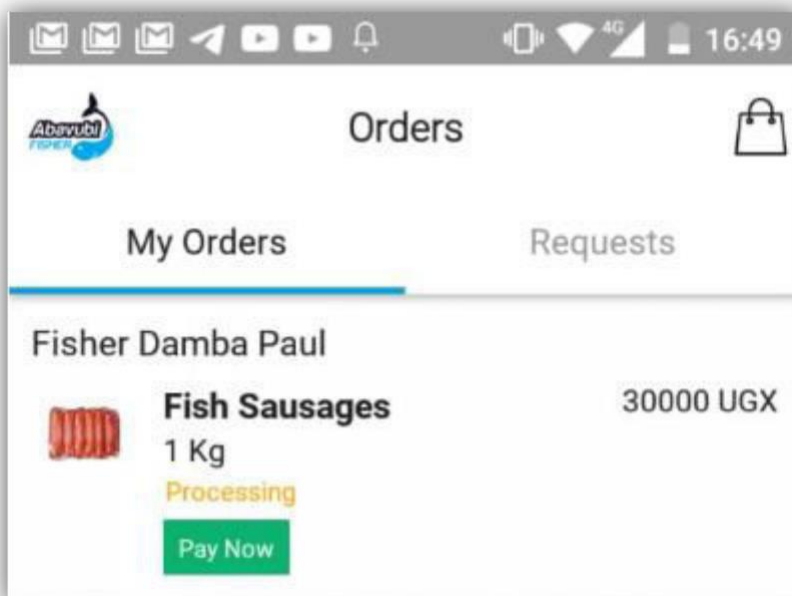


### i) Payments

#### Pay Now Button

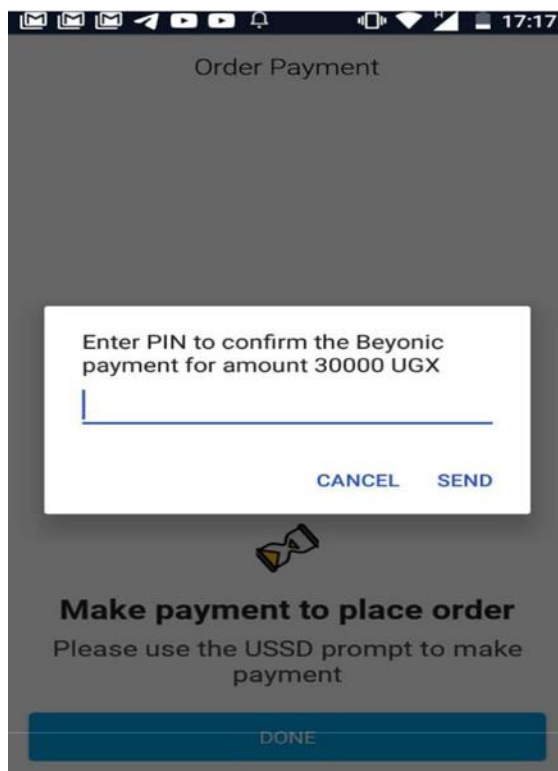
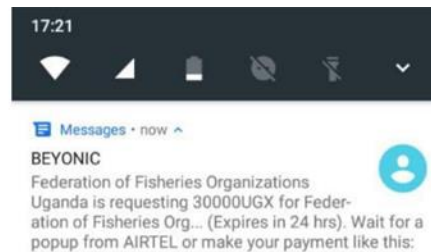
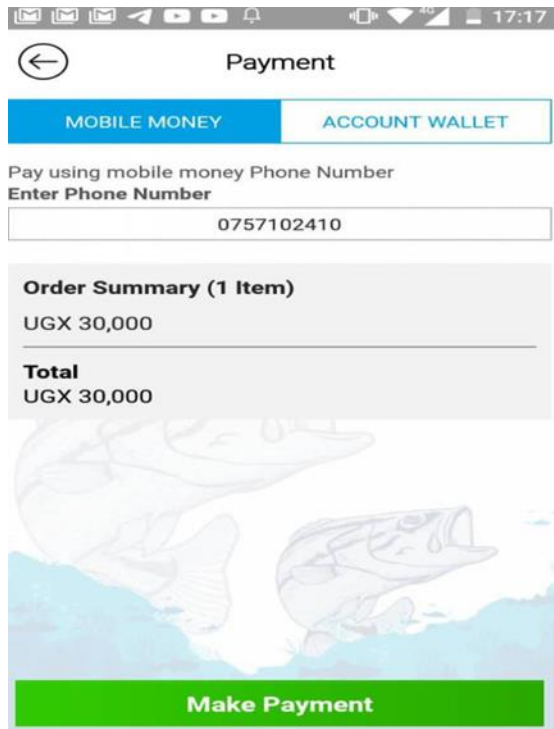
Pay now is the button that activates on client mobile when Fish and Fish products supplier has approved your order request.

## j) Initialising Payments

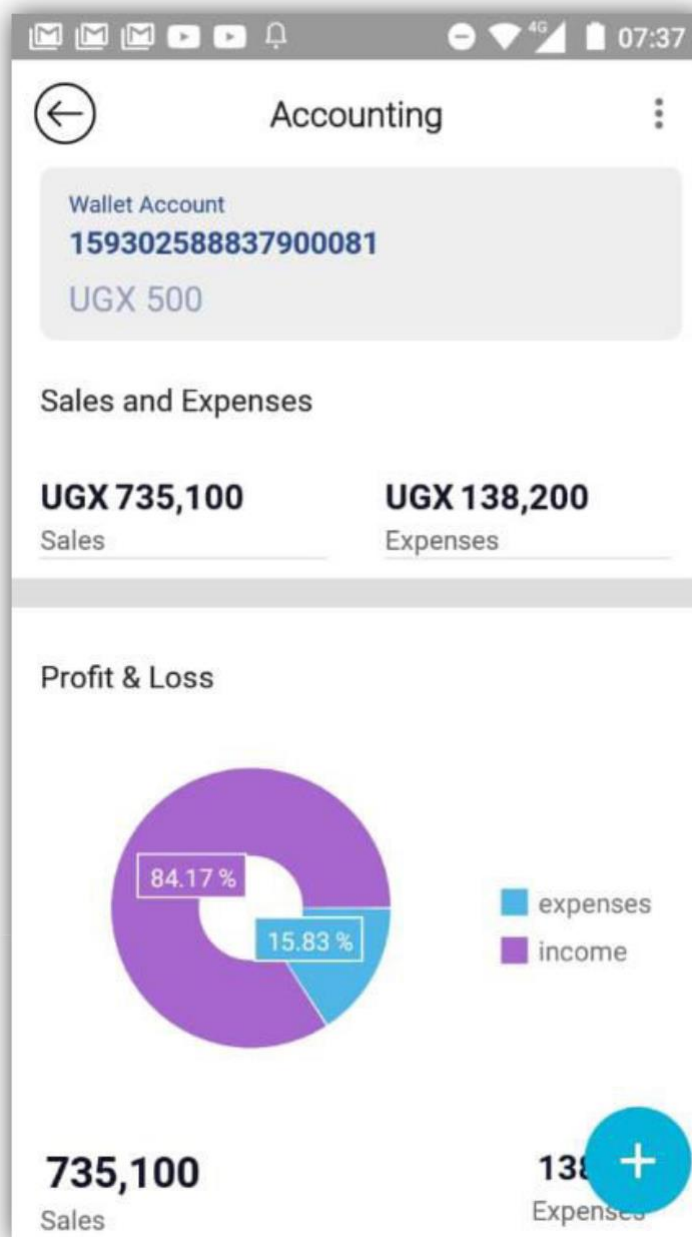
By making a payment, Message from our third party prompts customer to enter a MOBILE MONEY password that assures money to the sellers Account Wallet.



## 5.2 The Personal Accounting Module

### 5.2.1 Overview

This module contains an overview of Income, Expenses, Assets, Liabilities and financial statements from Fish Sales and Inputs. Based on these sales and expenses reports, and financial statements, a fisher can easily present their financial statement cumulated over a period of time to present them to financial institutions for credit facilities and soft loans.

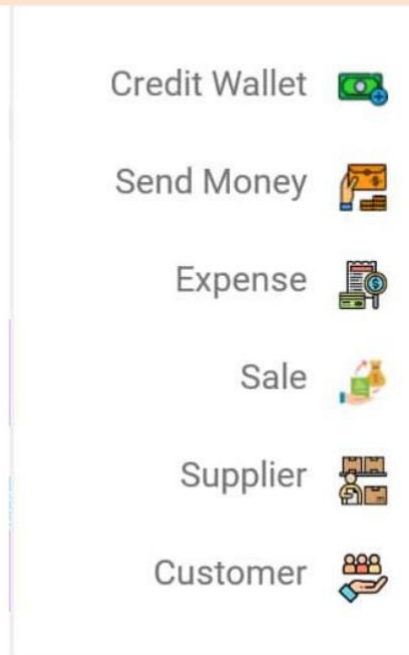


## 5.2.2 Adding data to the Personal Accounting Module

The Add (+) icon represents an entry to add raw data to the accounting module.



On the right, by clicking on the Add icon you can record customers, suppliers, sales, expenses, send money



## 5.2.3 Adding a customer

By clicking on Customer the form on the right opens requiring you to fill details of your customer, and then Save accordingly.

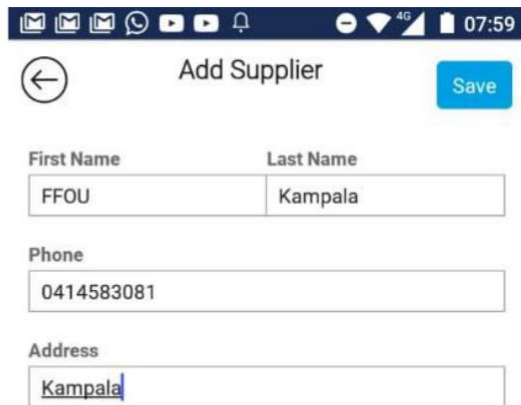
Remember the business owner would always want to inform his clients of new stocks and business innovations from time to time.

## 5.2.4 Adding a supplier

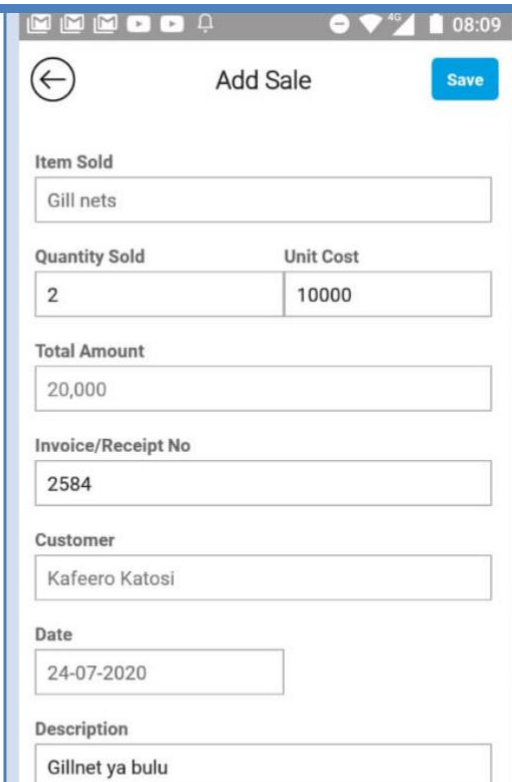

## 5.2.5 Adding a sale and an expense

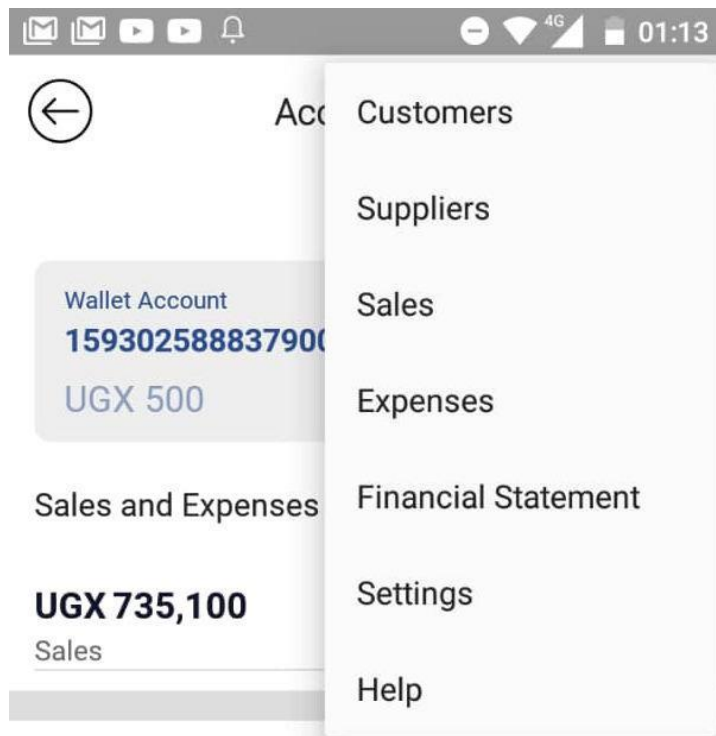

**5.2.6 Viewing Reports**



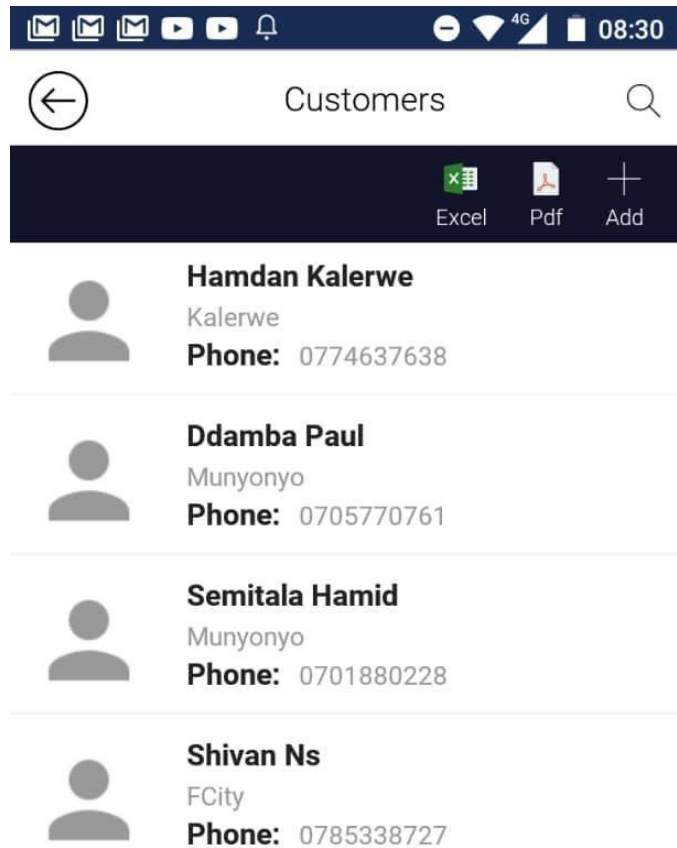
The reports are accessible by clicking the three buttons on the right top corner in the accounting module and the display above will pop.

### 5.2.7 Customer and Supplier Reports

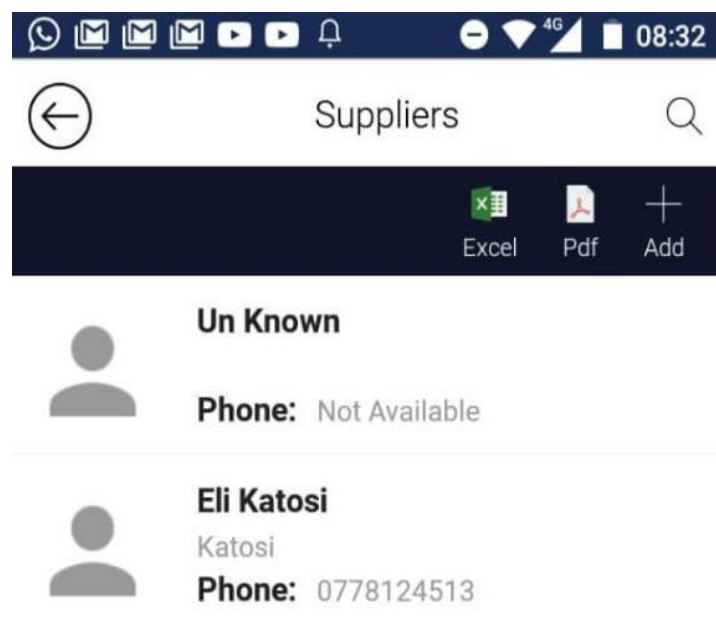
The customers and Suppliers reports both display customers and suppliers respectively.

As explained earlier, seller can record the customer or supplier with their easy way of memorization



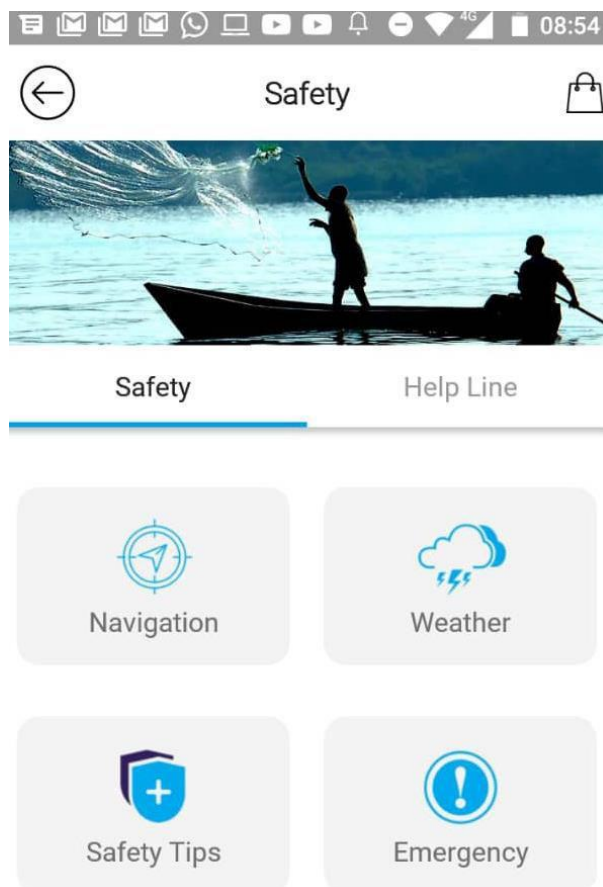

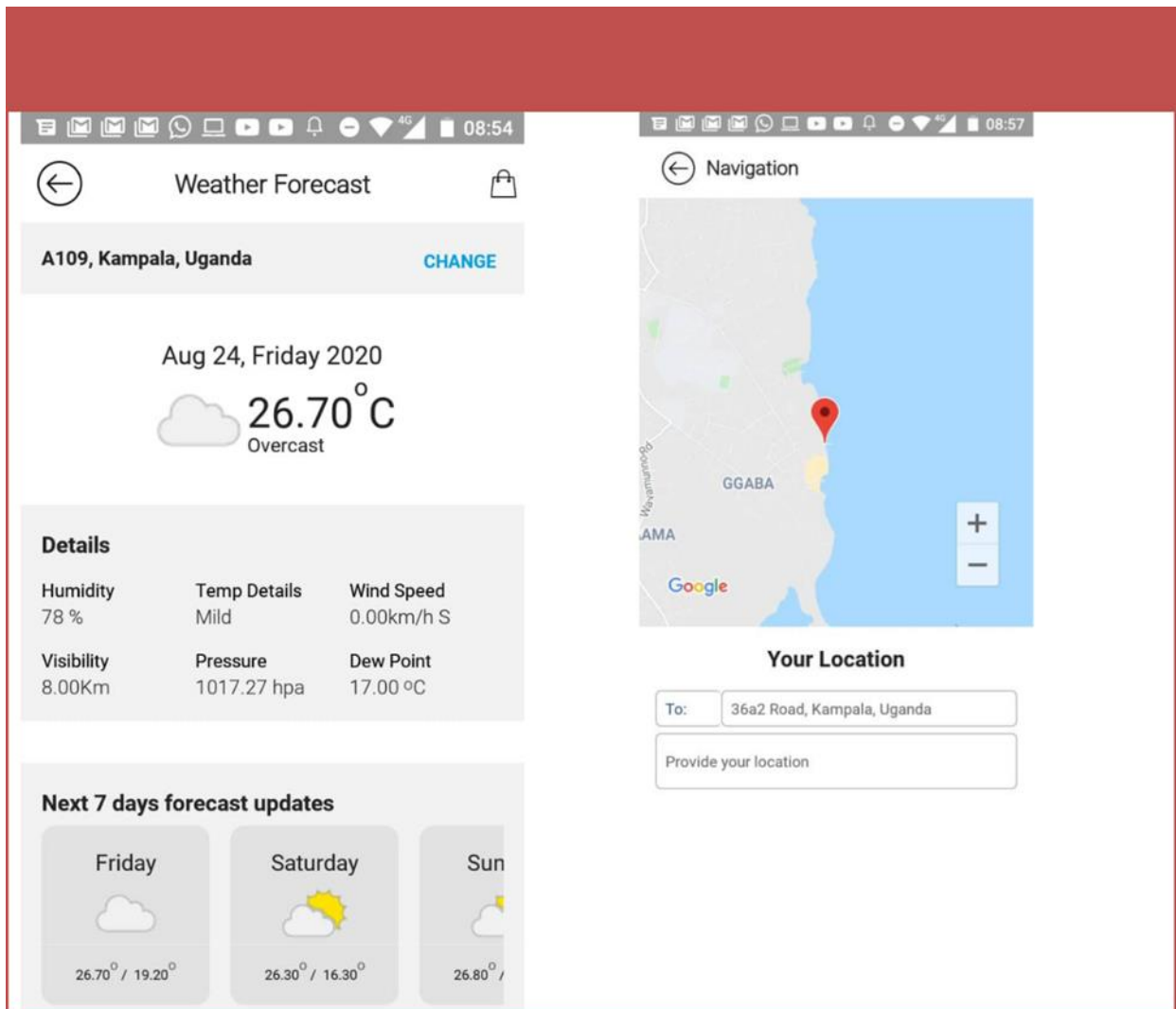
### 5.3 Safety & Navigation Module
