### 1. A brief summary of the assessment of DIT financed by GIZ and FFOU.

Federation appreciated the discussions held in a meeting with GIZ on the 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2023, this is where FFOU requested for financial support to acquire materials to be used during implementation of DIT assessment activity planned by the Federation. Having successfully implemented Business Development Services project (BDS) in the year 2022 across the 7 districts of Kampala, Kalungu, Mpigi, Mukono, Kalangala, Kyotera and Masaka, FFOU considered an innovation of empowering people through Directorate of Industrial Training (DIT) where promotion of marketable skilling would be priority by the Directorate. The Directorate highlighted Key areas of assessment as being Entrepreneurship, Fish processing and preservation.

To ensure success of the implemented DIT assessment, we required some tools and equipments for practical assessment of the prepared BDS trainees against which we submit this report for accountability and record purposes. The proposed budget for assessment was Ugx.18,375,000 which was required for procurement of the said materials. GIZ contributed 8,375,000 ug sh worth of materials and FFOU contributed 10,000,000 to ensure success of the assessment exercise. in partnership with the GIZ-RFBCP this DIT Assessment was to ensure sustainability of BDS skills attained. A total of 750 trainees in the 7 Districts were trained and assessed. These included 576 men and 174 women.

#### **General activity Objectives**

- To empower fisherfolk through Directorate of Industrial Training (DIT) the promotion of marketable skilling as a priority area.
- To assess 750 (174 women and 576 men) who are engaged in small and medium enterprises along the Fish value chain with business knowledge and skills.

#### DIT assessment delivery.

DIT assessment covered majorly two modules ie Fish handling and Fish preservation.

#### Key Deliverables / outputs.

- Enhanced entrepreneurship skills among the trainees.
- Marketing skills .
- fish preservation and handling skills.
- value addition skills.
- Improved fish quality that meets the standards.
- Over 700 BDS trainees was assessed pending graduation
- Improved record keeping, savings among the trainees.
